God's Plan for Us

"There are three things that are too
wonderful for me,
four that I do not understand:
the way of an eagle in the sky,
the way of a snake on a rock,
the way of a ship in the sea,
and the way of a man with a woman."

What is Intimacy?

- * Latin *intimus* inmost/innermost
- Close familiarity or friendship
- * Cosy, private, relaxed relationship
- * Knowledge of a subject: "an intimate knowledge of Medieval art"
- * Sexual intercourse, Genesis 4.17: Cain was "intimate/knew" his wife and she conceived...

Some Biblical Texts on Intimacy

- Psalms 16 Closeness (intimacy) with God
- * II Sam 7.10-17 God had an intimate father(Ab) relationship with Israel
- * Mark 14.35-36 Abba, Father! Jesus maintained an intimate relationship with God.
- * Matt 19.4-6 Marriage: One flesh, joined by God...

"I always let the Lord guide me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken. Therefore my heart is glad and my whole being rejoices; my body also rests securely. For you will not abandon me to Sheol; you will not allow your faithful one to see decay. You reveal the path of life to me; in your presence is abundant joy; at your right hand are eternal pleasures."

"I will designate a place for my people Israel and plant them, so that they may live there and not be disturbed again. Evildoers will not continue to oppress them as they have done ever since the day I ordered judges to be over my people Israel. I will give you rest from all your enemies.

"The Lord declares to you: The Lord himself will make a house for you. When your time comes and you rest with your fathers, I will raise up after you your descendant, who will come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. 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Our Body

* I Cor 6.12-20 – Christ's body and our bodies

""Everything is permissible for me," but I will not be mastered by anything. "Food is for the stomach and the stomach for food," and God will do away with both of them. However, the body is not for sexual immorality but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body. God raised up the Lord and will also raise us up by his power. Don't you know that your bodies are a part of Christ's body? So should I take a part of Christ's body and make it part of a prostitute? Absolutely not! Don't you know that anyone joined to a prostitute is one body with her? For Scripture says, The two will become one flesh. But anyone joined to the Lord is one spirit with him.

Flee sexual immorality! Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the person who is sexually immoral sins against his own body. Don't you know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought at a price. So glorify God with your body."

Our Body

- * I Cor 6.12-20 Christ's body and our bodies
- * We have become one with Christ's body at our spiritual birth
- * The implications of sexual contact are profound more than we fully understand...
- * Our sexuality affects many bodies:
 - * Our own body
 - * Our sexual partner In the Movie Vanilla Sky, Cameron Diaz says: "Don't you know that when you sleep with someone your body makes a promise whether you do or not."
 - * Christ's Body
- * Our sexuality cannot just be our private affair it implicates Christ's Body

Christ and the Church

* Ephesians 5.29-33 One flesh

"No one ever hates his own flesh but provides and cares for it, just as Christ does for the church, since we are members of his body. For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two will become one flesh. This mystery is profound, but I am talking about Christ and the church. To sum up, each one of you is to love his wife as himself, and the wife is to respect her husband."

Christ and the Church

- * Ephesians 5.29-33 One flesh, yet again
- Christ and the Church: an intimate relationship
- We need to think deeply about this parallel the mystery is profound
- * Ask ourselves: does my marriage/sexuality and the marriages around us inspire and inform understanding of Christ and the Church?

Thoughts about Intimacy

- Sex is the most intimate of human interactions
- * Sex requires vulnerability, trust, commitment, risk
- * Biblically, sex creates a bond that is not easily broken
- * Sex engenders intimacy: knowledge, familiarity, sense of privacy and shared experience, but it is not all there is to intimacy
- * There is a sacredness/holiness to this level of intimacy that we need to understand and nurture

God's Plan for Us

- * A great sex life is **not** God's key objective for our lives!
- * Intimacy with God is his plan: Jer 9.24, Psalms 42.1-4
- * Joy in intimacy with God is his plan: Eccl 2.26, Ps 87.7
- * Our sexuality and desire for intimacy create unsatisfied longings, but only God can satisfy our deepest needs for intimacy, to be truly known our desires often destroy God's plans for intimacy with us
- * Our sexuality and marriages can teach us profound things about God and the Church, but it is not an automatic outcome!

"" 'This is what the Lord says:
